Back in 2001, the two ex-Chandelier members Tom Jarzina (drums) and Stephan Scholz (bass & guitar) together with Julia Graff (vocals) helped ELLEVEN to take its first steps. Armin Riemer (keys) and Carsten Hütter joined a short time later and the band was complete. For the first album INSIGHT, Roger Weitz (Flying Circus, Thin Crow) not only engineered the album, but also played bass on it. The debut album was released in 2007 and immediately made it onto the "Eclipsed" magazine sampler. The atmospheric, rocking progressive pop received good reviews in Germany and other European countries. Professional and private reasons repeatedly forced the band to restructure. After Tom Jarzina had left the band in 2009, another Chandelier member joined on drums for the new material and the second album: Herry Rubarth became part of the band in 2010.
